<b>Class A Services- Preventative (Deductible waived) (i.e., Oral Examinations, X-Rays, Cleaning, etc) Limit 2 per person per plan year.</b>	100% of Allowable Charge	100% of Allowable Charge
<b>Class B Services- Basic (i.e., Space Maintainers, Oral Surgery, Composite</b>	80% of Allowable Charge	80% of Allowable Charge
<b>Class C Services- Major (i.e., Endodontics, Crowns, Inlays/Onlays, dentures, etc.)</b>	60% of Allowable Charge	80% of Allowable Charge
<b>Class D-Orthodontia Services (Dependent Children to age 20)</b>	60% of Allowable Charge (Not to exceed \$2,000 Lifetime Max Per Person)	80% of Allowable Charge (Not to exceed \$3,500 Lifetime Max Per Person)

<b>Plan Year Max (Class A,B,C combined)</b>	\$3,000.00	\$4,500.00
<b>Orthodontia Lifetime Max</b>	\$2,000.00	\$3,500.00

*Both plans will include a late enrollment penalty as follows: Class A services-no penalty, Class B services will have a 3 month waiting period before services are eligible for benefits. Class C and D services will have a six month waiting period before services are eligible for benefits. Late enrollment is defined as not enrolling in coverage the first time you are offered the insurance and enrolling at a later date. If you are in one of the plans listed above and change to the other plan, it will not be considered late enrollment. Making changes to coverage due to a qualifying event may be cause to have the late enrolment penalty waived.*
